TOPIC: PSEUDO BUBLAR AFFECT

A condition of emotional expression—crying and/or laughing that's exaggerated or doesn't match how you feel. It's different from depression. Hear several people share their emotions and experience.

Pseudo Bublur Affect (PBA) is a condition that causes uncontrollable crying and/or laughing that happens suddenly and frequently. It can happen in people with a brain injury or certain neurologic conditions.

A person having a crying spell may cry when they don't feel sad or when they only feel a little bit sad. Someone having a PBA laughing spell may laugh when they don't feel amused or when they only feel a little bit amused.
